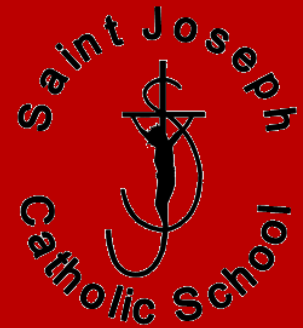
We look forward to seeing you and your family at our Book Fair! Remember, all purchases benefit our school.
