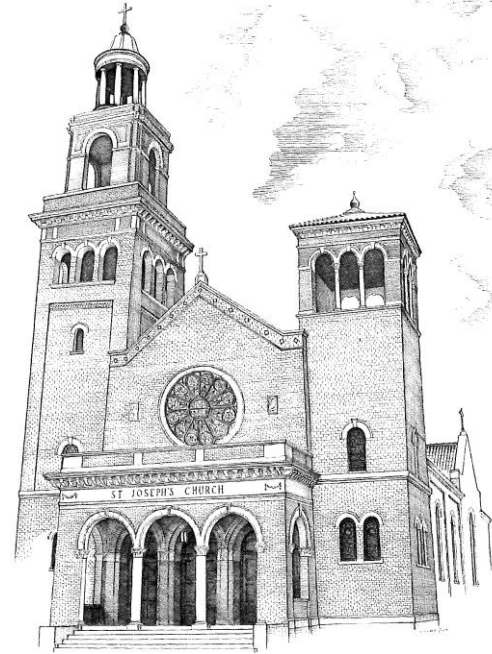

FROM FATHER BARNHILL

CHARITY & STEWARDSHIP APPEAL 2018: Bishop Conley has traveled the diocese and inaugurated the annual *Charity & Stewardship Appeal*. From his letter to be read at Masses this weekend, the bishop writes: In the Lincoln Diocese in southern Nebraska we have a special sense of what it means to cultivate the earth and bring forth the fruits of the land by labor, prudent care and common stewardship. In his public ministry Jesus often used these images from farming and agriculture to reveal the mysteries of his Kingdom. In Luke's Gospel, He spoke of those who, cultivating the seed of God's Word, "bear fruit through perseverance." (Luke 18:15)

This year's theme is "Stewardship: cultivating love in deed and truth." The bishop invites us to support the *Charity & Stewardship Appeal*. The bishop writes: "All of us are called, in one way or another, to cultivate and be generous stewards of our gifts... May we become the good stewards God has called us to be, because whenever we cultivate love in deed and truth we will "bear fruit" here on earth and in the heavenly kingdom to come."
