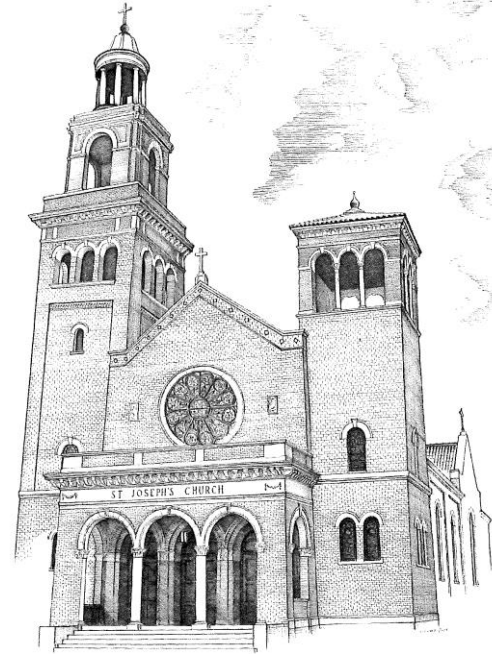

FROM FATHER BARNHILL

CHARITY & STEWARDSHIP APPEAL 2018: The Bishop's annual appeal supports work and apostolates across the Diocese of Lincoln. The diocesan goal is \$2.1 million divided between 5 beneficiary categories:

- 1) Proclaiming the Word: Office of Evangelization, Family Life Office, Youth Ministry, Camp Kateri, Newman Center, Retreat House, Hispanic Ministry
- 2) Works of Mercy: Catholic Social Services, Hospital & Nursing Home Ministry, Prison Ministry
- 3) Diocesan Ministries: Archives, Tribunal, Religious Sisters Retirement, Vatican Studies for Priests
- 4) Rebates to Parishes of 67% (our parish received \$14,482)
- 5) Appeal Administrative Costs of 4%

Our parish goal for St. Joseph, Beatrice is to pledge \$31,320 for the Charity & Stewardship Appeal. Last year, our parish pledged \$34,484 and has thus far received refunds of \$14,482 to support our Catholic school. 40% of the parish goal is returned to the parishes with one Catholic school. 100% of funds raised above parish goal are returned to the parish. The success of the bishop's appeal is in the number of participating households and families. Our diocese ranks higher than other Catholic dioceses in participation percentages. For example, last year 42% of families in our diocese pledged to the Charity & Stewardship Appeal. Saint Joseph, Beatrice had 142 pledges which averaged \$242. I was most happy to see that 98 of our pledges last year were for \$100 or more to the bishop's appeal.
