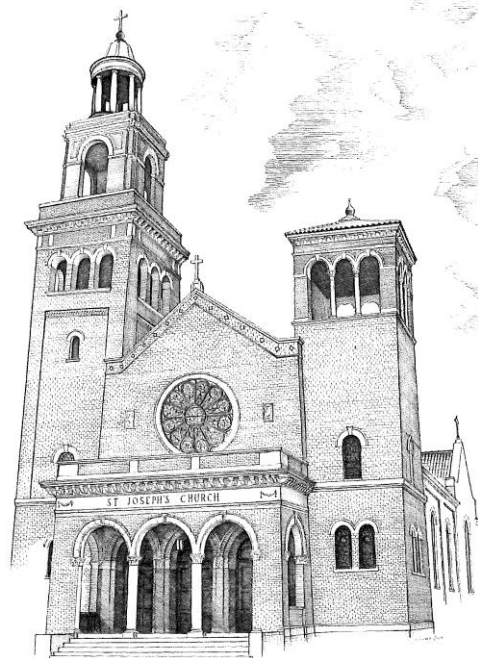

## FROM FATHER BARNHILL

**FATHER'S DAY:** Below is some information on Catholic husbands & fathers that I presented to our local Knights of Columbus men in April. It is a practical overview of suggested practices in the home and parish activities for men. The national chaplain for the Knights of Columbus wrote a similar article with some of this information. For example, he suggested 3 things for a Catholic husband & father:

**1) Be present** at home to your wife and children, helping to make the home a place of prayer, Christian love and open communication.

**2) Be active** in your parish & the community

**3) Be knowledgeable** about the Catholic faith to give testimony

Some men find it hard, or even undesirable, to engage in spiritual challenges that make them stand apart from the world. Others have very little information to rely on; little, if any, familiarity with regular devotions and disciplines that Catholic men engaged in for centuries. Other men no longer feel comfortable in the Church.

Another author, Chris Stefanick, wrote: "There are a lot of men's initiatives out there that I think give men a necessary boost of confidence and inspiration, a necessary boost of "spiritual energy." Those things can point our souls in the right direction, but its daily habits that change our lives forever."

**CHARITY & STEWARDSHIP APPEAL 2018** has one more week to accept pledge cards. Thus far, our parish of 385 family units has received 136 pledges (35% participation).
