FROM FATHER BARNHILL

END OF FISCAL YEAR REPORT: The Diocese of Lincoln requires each parish to submit an annual financial report, including a Balance Sheet, Profit & Loss Report, and an Annual Operating Budget. The fiscal year ended on June 30, 2018. Here are some financial numbers from the Saint Joseph Parish, Beatrice, Balance Sheet.

NOTES:

- 1) **Checking Account Balance**
Our two largest monthly payments are payroll for 22 church & school employees for \$39,000 a month. The 2nd large monthly payment is \$15,000 to the Diocese of Lincoln for insurance, retirement, *Southern Nebraska Register*, and diocesan administration shared by all Catholic parishes.
- 2) **Funds for Property Improvements**
A parish member, who wishes to remain anonymous, gave an estate gift from recent stocks sold. The amount was just over \$100,000 The request of the donor was to use the donation toward the demolition of the 601 Grant St. building (Masonic bldg.) and landscaping on the corner property.
- 3) **Joy of the Gospel Campaign Rebates**
The long term liabilities include a balance of \$85,000 on a no interest operating loan from the diocese. A payment was made on August 30th. The new balance on the operating loan is \$60,000.
- 4) **Catholic School Endowment of \$287,546** is a restricted amount in the Catholic Foundation of Southern Nebraska. Our Catholic school receives quarterly dividends from this fund.
- 5) **Major expenses in the next 2 months** are:
Verdin Bell Company \$11,130 for bell ringing hardware. The Knights of Columbus Council has agreed to share this cost.
Tiemann Construction has been contracted to demolish the Masonic building. Demolition & landfill costs are approximately \$45,000
