DIOCESE OF LINCOLN CATHOLIC SCHOOLS: The recent news story from the Diocese of Lincoln explains the new tuition and scholarship program for Catholic Schools, beginning in the 2019-2020 school year. This implementation will include our Saint Joseph Catholic School in Beatrice.

Our St. Joseph School parents were informed on January 25th that a new funding policy will be implemented.

The tuition changes along with the scholarship program are being made to increase the sustainability of our schools, to assist with increasing costs and teacher compensation, while reducing the financial burden to our parish.

Mr. Haake and I, in collaboration with the School Advisory Committee and the Finance Committee, are working through the details of the tuition and scholarship program. After careful and thorough discussions, Mr. Haake and I will inform our school families on main points of the announcement from the diocese.

You can learn more by reading the news articles in the Southern Nebraska Register. It highlights the Good Shepherd Scholarship Fund, which will help families with tuition assistance from the diocese. The Saint Joseph School tuition amount will also include a new parish scholarship for our eligible school families.

The benefits of a new tuition and scholarship program will be the long-term viability and financial sustainability of our Catholic School.
