FROM FATHER BARNHILL

CATHOLICS IN SOUTHERN GAGE COUNTY are members of Catholic parishes in Beatrice, Wymore, Odell or Barneston. An announcement is forthcoming from Bishop Conley (May 14) that St. Joseph, Beatrice will have 3 mission parishes under its care. Clergy assignments this week will include the announcement that there will be 2 priests assigned in the Beatrice; only one as pastor of Beatrice, Wymore, Odell and Barneston together. The second is the resident priest to work alongside the pastor in care for the souls of southern Gage County.

The Diocese of Lincoln allocation of Catholic priests recognizes the need of two priests at Saint Joseph Parish, Beatrice, with the Catholic school, healthcare facilities, sacramental requests, and total population. Wymore, Odell and Barneston will continue to have their parish organizations and social activities as well as religious education (CCD). Baptisms, funerals, holyday Masses will continue what will be the mission parishes.

Bishop Conley has asked me to speak to the Catholics in Wymore this weekend at their 10:30 Sunday Mass. My Sunday homily to them is on the theme of Jesus, the Good Shepherd. A shepherd knows his sheep and cares for their needs; never abandoning them. St. Mary in Odell and St. Joseph in Barneston have long been mission parishes. Now, St. Mary in Wymore will join them in the designation as a mission parish to Beatrice.

Why is Wymore becoming a mission parish? Because of the allocation of available priests in the Diocese of Lincoln. "This is not necessarily a permanent pronouncement," said Bishop Conley more than once in his discussion with me. More diocesan priests can lead to more available pastors in our rural diocese.

New assignments are effective on Monday, June 17th. St Joseph, Beatrice can anticipate its 2nd priest in the rectory. Also, an announcement will be made of a transitional deacon being assigned to St. Joseph, Beatrice in the months of June & July with residence in the rectory.
