FROM FATHER MARNENI

I was born April 5, 1958. God made me born as a twin – boy & girl in the Marneni family. Jojaniah (my father) and Rabekamma (my mother) were from the village Bhimavavam in the Country of India. I am Balaraju and my twin sister is Victoria. We received our names from the European missionary priest.

All my education from first to tenth grades was in the Catholic missionary schools run by Nuns or by St. Gabriel brothers. It was a sadness for my family that my father passed on December 8, 1967. I was 9 years old. My mom was 35 years old. This sad event made my mom to raise all her children. The older, a sister, is 13 years older & the younger, a brother, is 3 years younger.

While I was in seventh grade, God's call touched me through the Franciscan Sisters of Mother Mary. I joined the minor seminary for my eighth grade year, then did all my studies until I was ordained a priest on March 9, 1986.

I am so proud to say that my Father's family was able to give us four priests and four nuns. My mother's family has six nuns. Only God's grace and blessings on our families. Today I am here at St. Joseph Parish, Beatrice, by the plan of God.
