FROM FATHER BARNHILL

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS (Continued): Last week I mentioned interior church projects upcoming as well as some exterior projects such as expansion of south parking and landscaping the former Masonic lot.

The 601 Grant Street property (former Masonic) is slated to be *green space* to complement the intersection with the courthouse and post office buildings nearby. Green space will include turf grass from the center to the west property line (Highway 77). The east end will have mulched berms. On and around the berms will be native Nebraska trees. The ReTree Nebraska Program accepted our application for 10 free trees. Trees arrive between September 22-28 from the Nebraska Statewide Arboretum.

A matching fence to our playground is for the safety of our schoolchildren. The fence and new vehicle gates will replace the north chain link fence. A fence will be added under the current basketball rims.

A new flagpole (15 foot) has arrived and will be installed on the southeast corner of the property, in memory of Cliff Simmons. Schoolchildren raise & retire the American flag each school day.

Our current grounds maintenance is through our volunteer, Harold Nielsen, who does mowing, trimming, weeding and planting annuals. A new turf sprinkler system will keep the greenspace and berms watered.

Those involved thus far in the landscape planning are: George Pinkerton, Harold Nieslen, Spencer Hagemeyer, Mike Zarybnicky, and input on ReTree from Dean Cole. Tiemann Construction leveled the corner property and brought soil for the berms. Andrew Haake did some preliminary design and grant writing. We accepted a bid from Mark Schaaf to install the turf grass sprinklers. Homestead Fence of Wymore will install the aluminum fence & gates.
