FROM FATHER BARNHILL

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS at St. Joseph Parish have had changes and improvements this year. The Masonic building was demolished to make room for green space, which will be landscaped this month. The white rental house was demolished in July to make room for a future parking area. I met with the city engineer last week to get specifications for setbacks and parking lot layout.

The gym on the top floor of the Catholic school now has air conditioning. Gala fundraiser money purchased the units installed by Beatrice Mechanical Services & Adams Electric.

Preliminary project bids are being gathered for church interior renovations. This includes new heat & air conditioner units also.

Now that the long term operational debt has been paid (was over \$100,000) it is time to balance the budget and put aside funds for the next big project – church interior renovations and related maintenance to our almost 100 year old church building.
