## FROM FATHER BARNHILL

**WORLD DAY OF THE POOR:** Pope Francis established World Day of the Poor in 2017 as part of his ongoing mission to further focus the Catholic Church on service to the poor. The message of the Holy Father this year for the third annual World Day of the Poor is for Catholics to embrace those trapped in poverty.

He writes, “Brothers and sisters, I encourage you to seek, in every poor person whom you encounter, his or her true needs, not to stop at their most obvious material needs, but to discover their inner goodness, paying heed to their background and their way of expressing themselves, and in this way to initiate a true fraternal dialogue.”

Pope Francis goes on to say, “The poor need our hands, to be lifted up; our hearts, to feel anew the warmth of affection; our presence, to overcome loneliness. In a word, they need love.”

November 17, 2019 is World Day of the Poor – the 34<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time.
