FROM FATHER BARNHILL

STEWARDSHIP OF TREASURE: You may know that I turned 60 years old in 2019. Military retirement to former National Guard members begins at age 60. Therefore, I am now earning a retirement income through the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (your tax dollars) along with my monthly salary as an active pastor of Beatrice, Wymore, Odell, & Barneston.

I share this because of my personal need for the stewardship of treasure. We should approach everything in life – even our finances – with Christ in mind. How can we use our income to give glory to God? How much should I be giving for church support? My monthly income & expenses need adjusting.

In thanksgiving for God's gifts as a Christian disciple, my financial resources must be viewed through the lens of tithing. In the Scripture Old Testament, the commandment of tithing was giving 10 percent to support the Levite priests and their mission work. The Catholic Church invites all parishioners to consider using financial resources to support the Church and the poor. The scripture tithe is recommended as 5% to God through the offertory, 1% to diocese collections, and 4% to other charities and causes. Granted, legitimate exceptions to the 10% tithe apply to families living in poverty or limited income to meet their basic needs. Those who have the ability should make their best effort to tithe.

I am in the praying stage – asking God's guidance to sacrificial giving of my income. I've asked a financial advisor to assist me to be sure I have a vision of my retirement income needed at age 75. Please consider with me working to give 5% of income to the parish. Try increasing your weekly income incrementally until you reach the amount that you know is right for you and your family.

"How much should I be giving for church support?" This is the stewardship of treasure question for each of us to consider. The 5/4/1% tithing formula (parish, charities, and diocese) is a proven useful method for Catholics.
