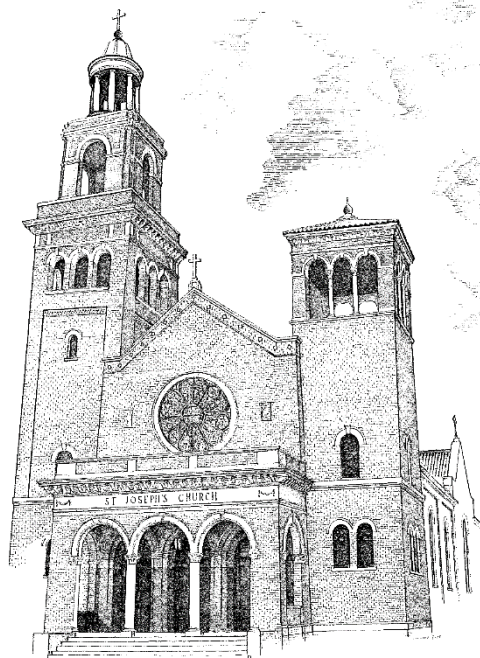

FROM FATHER BARNHILL

THANKSGIVING MESSAGE: The Catholic parishes of southern Gage County (Beatrice, Wymore, Odell, Barneston) had the unique opportunity to gather funds for a private school in India. Father Marneni is directly involved in the funding and development of the school.

From June to October 2019, India received the highest amount of monsoonal rain in the past 25 years. Father Marneni's family dwelling as well as the school he supports sustained damages from the rain, wind, mud slides and other related natural disasters. Therefore, Father Marneni returned to India from mid-September until the end of October to deal with family and school matters related to the monsoon damages.

On behalf of Father Marneni, **thank you** for the donations he received for disaster relief. The rain and government bureaucracy slowed down the initiation of the repair work. This week, repairs will begin on 3 classrooms of the private school. The donated funds from our parishes have been transferred to an account in India to be used for repairs.

Father Marneni says the some of the school children are currently attending school in a rice mill building converted into classrooms. The repairs will allow the children to return to their school building by June. Father Marneni, the school management and the school children give thanks to those of our parishes who donate a total of \$7,305 for school building repairs.
