




Red Raven Review

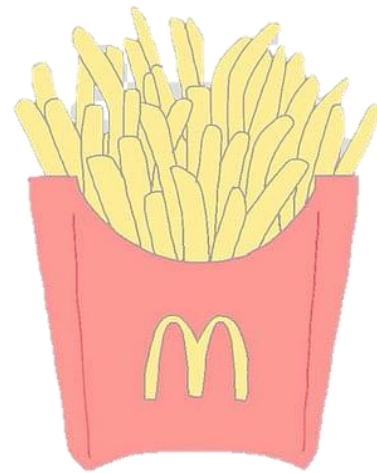
