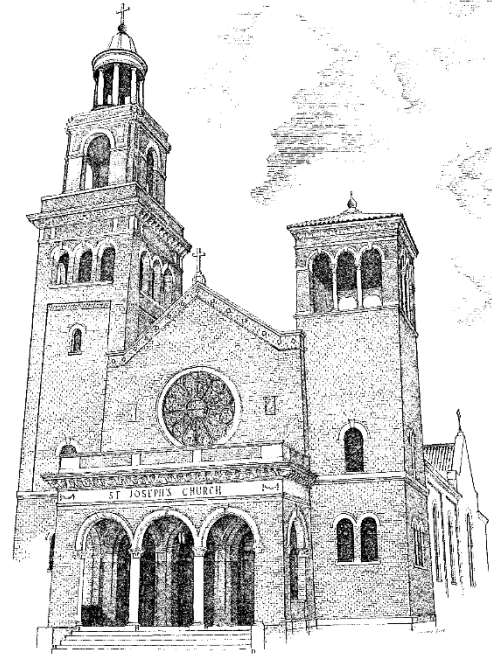

SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD is January 26th: Pope Francis has declared the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the word of God.

This new annual celebration inaugurates next Sunday, January 26, 2020. The desire is to emphasize the importance of the Bible in Catholic life and encourage one another to read and study the Bible as a regular part of our lives as disciples of Jesus Christ.

If you have ideas to make the Sacred Scripture more accessible to believers, let me know. Also, how can we as a parish increase our gratitude for so great a gift as the Word of God?

"Sunday of the Word of God" will occur each year in mid to late January. I am pastorally happy for this new initiative of the Catholic Church.

Suggestion 1: Read [The Bible is a Catholic Book](#), by Jimmy Akin. This book was distributed to the parish at Christmas Masses, compliments of the Knights of Columbus.

Suggestion 2: Touch the Bible everyday. Better yet, open the Bible everyday. Ideally, read from the Bible everyday.

Suggestion 3: Find others to join you in a Bible Study. Ask me for suggestions on appropriate material for study guides. Formed.org is a good start for individual or group study.
