St Joseph Catholic Church (including Wymore/Odell/Barneston payroll) received a Paycheck Protection Program loan. This loan is through the Small Business Administration (SBA) as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES). The loan paperwork is through First Security Bank in Beatrice. The loan is to help with the following:

- payroll costs including gross salary or wages, sick leave, and paid time off for employees for 8 weeks;
- contributions made to employee retirement plans;
- payment for the Church portion of employee group health care benefits, including insurance premiums;
- payment of state and local taxes assessed on compensation of employees

The loan is eligible to be forgiven (meaning it does not need to be paid back) on any portion used for the above reasons. If our payroll and other expenses come in at less than the amount of the loan, we will need to pay back the excess amount.
