Prayer to Saint Monica

UNTIL there is a vaccine, the Covid virus may be with us for some time. That means that if there are periodic outbreaks, our community or your family may be asked to quarantine again. Reflecting on how things went helps prepare for the next time you may be asked to stay home. Keep essentials stocked. It's always a good idea to have a couple of weeks' worth of nonperishable food and water on hand. Include long-lasting canned and dried foods, and rotate them out regularly. Restock your medicines, toilet paper, hand sanitizers, household cleaners and other items you deem or discovered were essential, but hard to find. And make sure everyone in the family has a washable cloth face mask. Keep a list of stores and restaurants which may offer online purchasing, home deliveries or curbside pickup, and know which of those accept benefits from SNAP and other assistance programs. Prepare for school closures and virtual learning if you have children. Create a social support network. Staying connected is good for your mental health. And we all need people we can call on for help when we can't go out. Make a list of friends, family and neighbors you can call for emotional support and practical help when needed. Remember to stay in touch even when things are going fine. Strengthen your financial safety net, but be a good steward and support those who were including you as their means to continue if at all possible. Plan ahead and try to set aside money to help you get by if you're unable to work. It may be best to keep this money in a separate savings account. Adding even a little here and there over time helps build a cushion. Remember—it never hurts to be prepared.
