There will be a meeting on August 31 at 6:30pm in the Parish Hall to review the Strategic Plan with the Implementation Projects for the school, building & grounds, faith & service, communications & outreach, and the financial goals in the 5 Year Budget with the St. Joseph community. SERVERS: Altar boys in Grades 3-5 will be trained or refreshed to serve at masses while in St. Joseph's school beginning in later August. Any boy in the same grades who is enrolled in another school and wants to serve is welcome to contact Fr. Rand and training will be set up for them. Boys in 6th grade and above are welcome to serve and get any refreshing needed while serving. After all training for everyone has been completed we will set up a schedule for weekend and holy day Masses for those able and willing to serve.

CCD: CCD grades 1-8 will begin in September. Registrations will be made available to those grades for whom we have teachers. Covid precautions will be worked into the class routines. We currently are in need of teachers for Grades 5/6 and 7/8. If no one is able or willing to teach, then the respective grades will fall to their parent's responsibilities at home using materials and online sources to assist them. We have asked a number of people without success, but are hoping someone can or will step forward to share instruction of the faith with the Lord at their side.
