**“TAKING IT IN STAGES”** At Mass in our parishes if the main celebrating priest extends the invitation for us to give the sign of peace to each other please do so in one of these three forms which do not require physical contact: a nod of the head, a smile or a hand wave. Out of an abundance of caution we will continue to not physically shake hands. At the option of the main celebrating priest on weekend Masses there may be a procession at the beginning of Mass and/or recessional at the end of Mass, however without the cross and other such hand held items.
